- (d) whether the Government of Andhra Pradesh has submitted any proposals for introducing new train services in the State; and**
- (e) if so, the details thereof including the steps taken in response to such proposals?**

**(a) to (e) No, Sir. No proposal for introduction of new train services has been received from the Government of Andhra Pradesh. However, Indian Railways do not introduce train services on State-wise basis as Railway network straddles across State boundaries. Further, introduction of new train services depends on operational feasibility, resource availability, traffic justification, competing demands etc., which is an on-going process.**
