- (a) the number of beneficiaries under the Integrated Skill Development Scheme during the years 2019-2020, 2020-2021, 2021-2022 and as on February, 2023, State-wise including Maharashtra;
- (b) the total number of textile training centres which have been registered and functioning across the country, under Samarth Scheme, State-wise including Maharashtra, Gujarat and Madhya Pradesh;
- (c) the details of the budget allocated and utilized for this purpose, State-wise;
- (d) whether the Ministry has partnered with Government agencies from various States and sectoral organizations for entry level training and job creation in both traditional and organized segments of textile value chain; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof, State-wise especially in the State of Maharashtra?

(a): Ministry of Textiles had implemented the umbrella skilling scheme of Integrated Skill Development Scheme (ISDS) during 2010-2018 for skill development and capacity building of workers across textile value chain. In further continuation, the revamped skilling scheme of Samarth-Scheme for Capacity Building in Textile Sector (SCBTS) was launched in 2017-18. Samarth provides demand driven, placement oriented National Skill Qualification Framework (NSQF) complaint skilling programme to supplement the efforts of the industry in creating jobs in the organized textile and related sector, covering the entire value chain of textiles, excluding Spinning and Weaving in organized sector. Details of beneficiaries under Samarth Scheme during the year 2019-20, 2020-21, 2021-22 and as on February 2023, State /UT-wise including Maharashtra is given **Annexure – I**.

(b): Under the umbrella skilling scheme of Samarth, a total of 1,703 registered training centres are functioning across the country including Maharashtra, Gujarat and Madhya Pradesh. State/UT-wise details are given in **Annexure-II**.

(c): There is no State-wise allocation of funds under Samarth. The cost of training programme under the scheme is released directly to Implementing Partners. A total of Rs.387.15 crore has been utilized under Samarth across the country during 2017-18 to 2022-23 which includes Rs.133.64 crore disbursed as liabilities of previous scheme i.e. ISDS.

(d) & (e): Ministry of Textiles has allocated training target to State Government Agencies from various States and Sectoral Organizations of Ministry of Textiles for entry level training and job creation in both traditional and organized segments of textile value chain. Details are given at **Annexure-III**.
