**MENTAL ILLNESS**

**4831. SHRI A. GANESHAMURTHI:**

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether any survey has been conducted to find out the number of patients cured of mental illness and are being kept illegally in hospitals and mental health institutions in the country and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the status of the Government mental healthcare institutions in the country;
- (c) whether National Human Rights Commission expressed concern over deplorable conditions of these institutions in terms of poor state of infrastructure and if so, the response of the Government thereto; and
- (d) the details of the measures taken to improve the conditions, including addressing the shortage of manpower in these institutions?

**ANSWER

- (a) The National strategy for inclusive and community-based living for persons with mental health issues, 2019 finds about 32% of mental hospital beds in India are estimated to be occupied by long-stay service users.
- (b) There are 47 Government run mental hospitals in the country, including 3 Central Mental Health Institutions, State-UT wise list of these institutions is enclosed at Annexure.
- (c) & (d) National Human Rights Commission (NHRC) had issued notice to Ministry of Health and Family Welfare and the Chief Secretaries / Principal Secretaries, Health, of all the State Governments as well as Administrators of Union Territories on the issue of keeping the mentally cured patients even after recovery for inordinate period in contravention of Section 19 of Mental Health Act, 2017.

To enhance the capacity of health services in the country, the Government of India is implementing the National Mental Health Programme (NMHP). Under the Tertiary care component of NMHP, 25 Centres of Excellence have been sanctioned to increase the intake of students in PG departments in mental health specialities as well as to provide tertiary level

treatment facilities. The Government has also supported 19 Government medical colleges/institutions to strengthen 47 PG Departments in mental health specialties. 22 AIIMS also have provision of Mental Health Services. These services are also available under PMJAY. Further, there are 47 Government run mental hospitals in the country, including 3 Central Mental Health Institutions.

The Government is supporting implementation of the District Mental Health Programme (DMHP) under the National Mental Health Programme in 716 districts of the country for detection, management and treatment of mental disorders/ illness with the major components of counselling in schools and colleges, work place stress management, life skills training, suicide prevention services and Information, Education and Communication (IEC) activities for generation of awareness and removal of stigma associated with Mental Illness.

Besides the above, the Government has launched a “National Tele Mental Health Programme” on 10<sup>th</sup> October, 2022, to further improve access to quality mental health counselling and care services in the country. As on 09.03.2023, 25 States/ UTs have set up 36 Tele MANAS Cells and have started mental health services. 63806 calls have been handled on the helpline number.
