PORT TERMINALS TO PRIVATE SECTOR UNDER PPP

4851. SHRI JAYADEV GALLA:

Will the Minister of PORTS, SHIPPING AND WATERWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of major port terminals that have been given to the private sector under PPP mode;
- (b) the concessionaire details of each of these terminals along with the type of terminals present in these ports and their capacities;
- (c) the number of bids that were received for each of these terminals along with the cost of the least quoted bid;
- (d) the list of minor ports that have been privatised along with the name of concessionaires;
- (e) the types of terminals that have been developed in these ports along with their capacities in each of the ports that have been privatized; and
- (f) the number of bids that were received for each of these minor ports along with the cost of the least quoted bid?

ANSWER

(a) to (c) : There are 12 Major Ports wholly owned by the Central Government. Private Sector Participation has been allowed in these Major Ports on Public Private Partnership (PPP) basis for project/berths/terminals through concession agreement for a fix tenure by way of bidding process on revenue share/royalty payment by the concessionaire. After the concession period gets over, the port asset is handed over to the Port Authority. In case of Major Ports, details of the Concessionaires, Projects, Capacity, and Cargo Type are at **Annexure-I**. Any information related to the process of bidding for a specific project is not centrally maintained by the Ministry.

(d) to (f) Minor Ports are controlled and managed by State Maritime Boards under the administrative control of respective State Government as such this information is not centrally maintained.
