DEATHS DUE TO COVID-19

Will the **MINISTER OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has any statistics regarding the total number of COVID-19 positive cases and deaths due to COVID-19 reported in the country so far and if so, the details thereof, State-wise;
- (b) whether the Government is aware of the details of deaths in India due to COVID-19 as collected by the World Health Organisation and if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (c) whether any difference has been noticed in the data on such death available with the Government and that of WHO and if so, the reasons therefor;
- (d) the details of the number of COVID-19 tests conducted and positive cases reported therein during the last year, month-wise and State-wise; and
- (e) whether the Government has recently issued an advisory in this regard and if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH & FAMILY WELFARE (DR. BHARATI PRAVIN PAWAR)

(a) to (e) As reported by States/UTs, as on 27th March 2023 a cumulative total of 4,47,05,952 confirmed cases of COVID-19 including 5,30,837 deaths have been reported in the country. State/UT wise numbers of tests conducted, cumulative cases & deaths due to COVID-19 as reported by the States/UTs is placed at **Annexure**.

As per data on cases and deaths due to COVID-19, as maintained by the World Health Organization

(https://who.maps.arcgis.com/apps/dashboards/73d1d3251de3435cbc0bc586230cc3ef), as on 27th March, 2023, a total of 5,30,837 deaths due to COVID-19 have been reported in the country.

In light of a gradual but sustained increase in trajectory of COVID-19 cases and seasonal circulation of pan-respiratory pathogens in the country, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare has issued detailed advisories on 10th, 16th and 25th March, 2023 and held review meeting with all States/UTs, highlighting the need for strengthening disease surveillance, increasing testing rates, focusing on whole genome sequencing of samples for COVID-19 cases, improving community awareness and review hospital preparedness for any surge in cases.
