# 4922. SHRI RAJENDRA DHEDYA GAVIT: SHRI BRIJENDRA SINGH: SHRI SAUMITRA KHAN: SHRI SUNIL BABURAO MENDHE:

Will the Minister of CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government proposes to increase the number of Jan Aushadhi Kendras by issuing licences to qualified persons and extending loans from the Banks to ensure that generic medicines are available with much greater ease;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) whether the Government proposes to add more generic medicines and equipment for sale from Jan Aushadhi Kendras and if so, the details thereof;

(d) whether the Government has received any requests from private companies seeking their participation in setting up Jan Aushadhi Kendras across the country and if so, the details thereof; and

(e) the details of the volume of selling and buying of the medicines at the Jan Aushadhi Kendras in the country during last three years, State/UT-wise including district-wise in Haryana?

### ANSWER

## MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF CHEMICALS & FERTILIZERS (SHRI BHAGWANTH KHUBA)

(a) & (b): In order to provide quality generic medicines at affordable prices to all citizens, especially the poor and the deprived ones, *Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Janaushadhi Pariyojana* (PMBJP) has been launched by the Department of Pharmaceuticals wherein about 9,182 dedicated outlets known as *Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Janaushadhi Kendras* (PMBJKs) have been opened all across the country as on 28.02.2023. A target to open 10,000 PMBJKs by March, 2024 has been kept.

Under the Scheme, an individual being D. Pharma/B. Pharma degree holder himself or any individual /organization who has employed D. Pharma/ B. Pharma degree holder for getting drug license from concerned State Government, is eligible to open PMBJK. In order to encourage people for opening PMBJKs, Government provides an incentive up to Rs. 5.00 lakh @ 15% of monthly purchases made, subject to a ceiling of Rs. 15,000/- per month to the Kendra owners. In addition, one-time additional incentive of Rs. 2.00 lakh is provided to the Kendras opened in North-Eastern States, Himalayan areas, Island territories and backward areas mentioned as aspirational district by NITI Aayog or opened by women entrepreneur, exserviceman, Divyang and SCs & STs.

(c): The product basket of PMBJP comprises of 1,759 medicines and 280 surgical devices as on 28.02.2023. The product basket is reviewed periodically by Pharmaceutical and Medical Devices Bureau of India (PMBI), the Implementing Agency of the Scheme based on feedback of various stakeholders, market demand and recommendations of an expert committee and new medicines and surgicals added.

(d): Government has adopted a franchisee like model under the Scheme inviting individual entrepreneurs, NGO, Society, Trust, Firm, Private Company, etc. to apply for establishing and running Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Janaushadhi Kendra (PMBJK). However, PMBI has not received any proposal from private companies for opening of Kendras.

(e): Financial year-wise details of the procurement of medicines and surgicals under the scheme during last three years are as under:

During the last three financial years, sales of Rs. 1993.01 Crore has been done by selling quality generic medicines through PMBJKs which have been opened across the country.
