## 5018. SHRIMATI JYOTSNA CHARANDAS MAHANT:

# Will the **MINISTER OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

(a) whether any facilities have been provided by the Government for tests and treatment for liver, kidney and heart vessel in the State Government hospitals;

(b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise including Chhattisgarh;

(c) the details of the technical facilities and financial assistance provided to the States for the treatment and prevention of the said diseases during the last three years along with the names of the schemes under which the said facilities and assistance have been provided; and

(d) the State-wise details thereof including the State of Chhattisgarh?

## ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (DR. BHARATI PRAVIN PAWAR)

- (a) to (d): The Department of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India provides technical and financial support to the States/UTs under the National Programme for Prevention and Control of Cancer, Diabetes, Cardiovascular Diseases and Stroke (NPCDCS). The programme includes the following,
- i. Strengthening infrastructure
- ii. Human resource development
- iii. Health promotion
- iv. Screening of 30 years and above population under Ayushman Bharat Health Wellness Centre
- v. Early diagnosis and management
- vi. Referral to an appropriate level of healthcare facility

Cardiovascular diseases (CVDs), Chronic Kidney Diseases (CKDs) & Non-Alcoholic Fatty Liver Diseases (NAFLD) are an integral part of NPCDCS. Under NPCDCS, the details of states/UT wise health care facilities available to tackle NCDs is attached at Annexure 1.

To facilitate accessible, affordable healthcare treatment, the following steps have been taken:

- Cardiovascular diseases, liver disease and chronic kidney disease patients are getting treatment at various health facilities in the health care delivery system including Medical Colleges, Central Institutes like AIIMS, Central Government hospitals, and private sector hospitals through PMJAY and State-based schemes.
- 2. There is also focus on various aspects of NCDs in case of new AIIMS and many upgraded institutions under Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojna (PMSSY).
- 3. Chronic Kidney Disease (CKD) is an integral part of the NPCDCS programme under the aegis of National Health Mission. Pradhan Mantri National Dialysis Programme (PMNDP) launched in 2016-17 for CKD patients ensures availability of dialysis services at the district hospitals in the country free of cost to all BPL beneficiaries. National Health Mission (NHM) supports States/UTs in implementation of Hemodialysis and Peritoneal Dialysis services under PMNDP based on the gap assessment done by the State/UTs through the annual Programme Implementation Plans (PIP). The State/UT wise hemodialysis units are attached at annexure 1

State/UT wise financial assistance for the treatment and prevention of non-communicable diseases (NCDs) during the last three years are attached at Annexure 2.
