HWCs SET UP UNDER PM-ABHIM

Will the **MINISTER OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of Health and Wellness Centres set up under the PM- Ayushman Bharat Health Infrastructure Mission (PM-ABHIM) in the rural areas since inception of the scheme, State/UT-wise, and district wise in Andhra Pradesh;
- (b) the total number of Block Public Health Units (BPHU) proposed to be supported in the state of Andhra Pradesh along with the number of BPHUs actually launched, district-wise;
- (c) the details of the 12 Central Hospitals in which the Critical Care Hospital Blocks are to be established;
- (d) the total number of Critical Care Hospital Blocks established, State/UT-wise; and
- (e) whether the Integrated Health Information Portal (IHIP) has been proposed for launch across all States/UTs and if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) to (e) PM-ABHIM is a Centrally Sponsored Scheme with some Central Sector Components to fill critical gaps in health infrastructure, surveillance and health research – spanning both the urban and rural areas. The measures under the scheme are aimed at strengthening health systems and institutions in order to provide a continuum of care at all levels, namely primary, secondary, and tertiary, as well as preparing health systems to respond effectively to current and future pandemics and disasters.

Under CSS component of the scheme, support is provided to set up 17788 AB-HWC's (Ayushman Bharat- Health and Wellness Centres) in rural areas during the scheme period of 2021-22 to 2025-26. State/UT wise details are at Annexure-I. Under the Scheme provision has been made to provide support for establishment of 602 Critical Care Hospital Blocks (CCBs) during the scheme period. Details of State/UT wise approvals accorded in FY 2021-22 & FY 2022-23 under PM-ABHIM is at Annexure-II.

The state of Andhra Pradesh has been provided infrastructure support under the scheme for establishment of 775 Ayushman Bharat-Health and Wellness Centres in Urban Areas (U-HWCs), 13 District Integrated Public Health Labs (IPHLs) and 13 Critical Care Hospital Blocks during the scheme period 2021-22 to 2025-26.

Under Central Sector Component support is provided under the Scheme for establishment of Critical Care Hospital Blocks in 12 Central Hospitals namely AIIMS at Delhi, Bhopal, Bhubaneswar, Jodhpur, Patna, Raipur and Rishikesh, PGIMER at Chandigarh, JIPMER at Puducherry, RIMS at Imphal, NEIGRIMS, Shillong and IMS of BHU at Varanasi.

Integrated Disease Surveillance Program (IDSP) was launched with an aim to detect and respond to disease outbreaks quickly and to strengthen the disease surveillance in the country.

Further to improve the surveillance system, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare has launched “Integrated Health Information Platform (IHIP)” which is implemented in a phased manner across all the States/UTs. The portal captures more than 33 epidemic prone diseases.
