## SCHOLARSHIP AT PRIMARY LEVEL

#### 5089. SHRI KUMBAKUDI SUDHAKARAN: SHRI SUNIL KUMAR SINGH:

Will the Minister of TRIBAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:-

(a) whether there any scholarship schemes for the Schedule Tribe students at the primary school level, if so, the details thereof;

(b) the details of higher education and foreign education scholarships have been given by the Government for the welfare of ST students under different schemes;

(c) the budgetary expenditure for the last five years for such schemes; and

(d) the details of students from Scheduled Tribe who dominates district of Jharkhand and have been benefited under this scheme?

#### ANSWER

# MINISTER OF STATE FOR TRIBAL AFFAIRS (SHRI BISHWESWAR TUDU)

(a): The Ministry of Tribal Affairs gives scholarship to ST students from Class IX & X under Pre-Matric Scholarship Scheme whose parental annual income is up to Rs.2.50 lakhs.

(b): Details of higher education and foreign education scholarships implemented by the M/o Tribal Affairs for the welfare of ST students is as under:

(1) **Post Matric Scholarship for ST students (Class XI and above)**: It is a Centrally Sponsored Scheme implemented through respective Ste/UT administrations. This is an openended Scheme covering all ST students studying in class XI and above, whose parental annual income is up to Rs. 2.50 lakhs. The contribution from Government of India is 75% and the state contribution is 25%. In respect of North East states and hilly states, the contribution from Government of India is 90% and the state contribution is 10%. In case of UTs like Andaman & Nicobar without Legislative Assembly and own grants, Govt. of India's contribution is 100%.

(2) **National Scholarship Scheme:** Under this Central Sector Scheme, Scholarship is provided to ST for pursuing Graduate/Post Graduate courses in the 252 notified top class institutes such as Management, Medicine, Engineering, Information Technology, Law etc, whose annual parental income is upto RS. 6 lakhs.

(3) National Fellowship Scheme for Higher Education of ST Students: Under this Central Sector scheme, scholarship is provided to 1000 meritorious ST students every year for pursuing M.Phil or Ph.D in India.

(4) **National Overseas Scholarship for ST students:** It is a Central Sector Scheme scholarships are given to 20 meritorious Schedule Tribe (ST) students every year for pursuing higher education in reputed Institutes/Universities abroad, whose parental income is up to Rs.6 lakhs per annum.

(c): Details of fund released during last five years under above mentioned 4 higher education and foreign education scholarships schemes is given below:
