IDENTIFICATION OF VILLAGES FOR RURAL TOURISM

5126. DR. MOHAMMAD JAWED:

Will the Minister of TOURISM be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the villages identified for giving a fillip to rural tourism in the country, State-wise particularly in Bihar;
- (b) the details of the funds allocated for the promotion of rural tourism in the country;
- (c) whether work has commenced to improve the condition of roads as well as the surroundings of the villages; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF TOURISM

(SHRI G. KISHAN REDDY)

(a) to (d): Ministry of Tourism identified Rural Circuit as one of the thematic circuits under its Swadesh Darshan Scheme. The details of the projects sanctioned under the Rural Circuit theme of the Scheme are given at Annexure-I.

Ministry of Home Affairs has informed that Vibrant Village Programme (VVP) has been approved for comprehensive development of 2967 villages in 46 blocks of 19 districts in Arunachal Pradesh, Sikkim, Uttarakhand, Himachal Pradesh and UT of Ladakh on northern border. Ministry of Rural Development has informed that one of the Rural Development scheme under implementation is Shyama Prasad Mukherji Rurban Mission (SPMRM). SPMRM was launched on 21st February 2016 with attempts to make the selected rural areas in form of the cluster, socially, economically and physically sustainable regions by providing economic, social and infrastructure amenities, thus leading to sustainable and balanced regional development in the country. 300 Rurban Clusters with thematic economic growth points are being developed across the country under this innovative Mission.

Under SPMRM, clusters are not exclusively developed as Tourism clusters, rather the Mission focuses on holistic development of clusters and to ensure an optimum level of development, twenty-one components have been suggested as desirable for the Cluster development. Among the 21 components, Tourism promotion is one of the major component. Total investments of Rs.478.70 crore have been approved both under Critical Gap Funding and Convergence under Tourism Promotion. The State/Cluster-wise investment proposed under Tourism promotion component is given at Annexure-II.
