INCREASE IN THE FUNDING TO STATES UNDER RUSA

5137. SHRI HIBI EDEN:

Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has increased the funding to States under Rashtriya Uchcharat Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA), if so, the details, State/UT-wise, FY- wise;
- (b) whether under Rashtriya Uchcharat Shiksha Abhiyan the Government has provided fund to educational institutions in Ernakulam district, Kerala under the RUSA, if so, the details including the list, name of colleges, locations, amounts, FY-wise etc., and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (c) whether the Government has any plans to increase the allocation of funds to educational institutions in Ernakulam district, Kerala under the RUSA, if so, the details and if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (d) whether the Government has provided any support or assistance to Maharaja's College and Government Law College at Ernakulam to help them access and utilize RUSA funding; if so, the details, since its inception?

ANSWER

(a) to (d): In a financial year, funds under Rashtriya Uchcharat Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA) are released to States, on the basis of fulfilment of certain conditions by the State such as transfer of the corresponding state share, utilisation of at least 75% of released funds, compliance of conditions laid down by the Project Approval Board (PAB) and compliance of the instructions of Ministry of Finance and availability of funds in the financial year. The second phase of the scheme was approved till 31st March 2020 and the structure of the third phase of the scheme is currently being finalised. In the interim period, only committed liabilities of the projects approved in the previous phases under the scheme is being released. The details of funds released to various States/ UTs under the scheme, in the last three years is placed at Annexure-I.

The details of the funds released under RUSA in the last three years i.e. 2020-21 to 2022-23 to institutions approved in Ernakulam district of Kerala, is placed at Annexure-II. The Government Law College, Ernakulam, has not been approved any central support under the scheme. Furthermore, under the scheme, Maharaja's College, Ernakulam, has been released central support amounting to Rs. 1.20 crore since inception of the scheme.
