SKILL DEVELOPMENT TRAINING

5158. SHRI VIVEK NARAYAN SHEJWALKAR:

Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has conducted any survey regarding the number of people who have received skill development training;
- (b) if so, the district-wise details of Madhya Pradesh; and
- (c) the number of young men and women who have received skill development training in Madhya Pradesh and got employment in organised and Government sectors during the last three years?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP

(a) and (b) As per the Periodic Labour Force Survey (PLFS) (2020-21), 3.3% and 13.6% of persons in the age group of 15-59 years received formal and other than formal vocational training, respectively.

Under Skill India Mission, the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) delivers Skill, Re-Skill and Up-Skill training to all the sections of the society, through an extensive network of skill development Centres/ Institutes across the country, under various schemes viz. Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY), Jan Shikshan Sansthan (JSS), National Apprenticeship Promotion Scheme (NAPS) and Craftsmen Training Scheme (CTS) through Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs). The district-wise number of beneficiaries trained under PMKVY, JSS, NAPS and CTS in the State of Madhya Pradesh during the last three years viz. 2019-20 to 2021-22 is at **Annexure-I, Annexure-II, Annexure-III** and **Annexure-IV** respectively.

(c) During the last three years viz. 2019-20 to 2021-22, the number of persons including men, women and transgender trained under various schemes of MSDE in the state of Madhya Pradesh is as under:

PMKVY had two components namely Short Term Training (STT) and Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL). Placement opportunities were facilitated to STT certified candidates, while RPL was not linked with placements as it recognized the existing skills of candidate. Under the Short term training (STT) component of PMKVY 3.0, successfully certified candidates provided with placement opportunities. Under the STT component of PMKVY, a total of 1,62,739 persons have been trained in the State of Madhya Pradesh, out of which 1,24,608 have been certified and 85,282 have been reported placed/ self-employed. As regards other Schemes, as per the third party evaluation reports, there is success in terms of

placement or enhancement of income of candidates trained. As far as JSS scheme is concerned, third party evaluation report of the scheme observed that as an impact of the training programme conducted at JSSs, the self and wage employment and private job have become evident. The report has further observed that usefulness of the scheme would be further evident from the fact that 77.05% of the beneficiary trainees have undergone occupational shifts. The final report of Tracer Study of ITI Graduates (published in January 2018 by the Ministry of Skill Development & Entrepreneurship, GoI) mentions that 63.5% of total ITI pass-outs got employed (wage+self, out of which 6.7% are self-employed).
