Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) whether any steps taken by the Government for creating a entrepreneurial ecosystem especially in the Mayiladuthurai and Nagapattinam District of Tamil Nadu and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) fund allocation for such schemes and initiatives during the last five years specifically for Tamil Nadu, year-wise; and
- (c) the list of beneficiaries benefited during the last five years, district-wise specifically in the Mayiladuthurai constituency in the State of Tamil Nadu?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP

(SHRI RAJEEV CHANDRASEKHAR)

- (a) Under Skill India Mission, Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) delivers skill, Re-Skill and Up-Skill training programmes and development of entrepreneurship across the country through an extensive network of skill and entrepreneurship development centres/Institutes under various Schemes. The brief of these Institutions/Schemes are as under:
- (i) National Institute for Entrepreneurship and Small Business Development (NIESBUD): NIESBUD is an autonomous entrepreneurship development Institute under the aegis of MSDE. NIESBUD aims to promote entrepreneurship as an alternate career choice and provide handholding support to potential and early-stage entrepreneurs, by imparting entrepreneurship education and mentoring support to trainees/ beneficiaries. NIESBUD has its office in NSTI, Chennai, Tamil Nadu for creating an entrepreneurial ecosystem in Tamil Nadu. NIESBUD is imparting entrepreneurship training in Tamil Nadu from the State office at NSTI, Chennai. However, no training programmes were conducted in Mayiladuthurai and Nagapattinam district of Tamil Nadu. The activities undertaken in Tamil Nadu are as under:

MSDE through NIESBUD has implemented a pilot project on entrepreneurship development under PM-YUVA scheme in 12 States/UTs including Assam, Bihar, Delhi, Kerala, Meghalaya, Maharashtra, Puducherry, Telangana, Tamil Nadu, Uttar Pradesh, Uttarakhand, and West Bengal from November 2019 to March 2022.

- (ii) Indian Institute of Entrepreneurship (IIE), Guwahati: IIE is an autonomous entrepreneurship development Institute under the aegis of MSDE. IIE aims to promote entrepreneurship as an alternate career choice and provide handholding support to potential and early-stage entrepreneurs, by imparting entrepreneurship education and mentoring support to trainees/ beneficiaries primarily from North Eastern Region (NER).
- (iii) Jan Shikshan Sansthan (JSS) scheme: The main aim of the JSS Scheme is to impart vocational and self employability skills to the non-literates, neo-literates and the persons having rudimentary level of education upto 8th standard and school dropouts upto 12th standard in the age group of 15-45 years, with due relaxation in case of 'Divyangjan' and other deserving cases. Priority is given to Women, SC, ST, OBC and Minorities. JSS in the State of Tamil Nadu are functional at Kancheepuram, Madurai, Nagapattinam, Namakkal, Sivaganga, Thiruvarur, and Tiruchirappalli.
- **(iv) Craftsmen Training Scheme (CTS):** This scheme is for providing long-term training through Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) across the country. The ITIs offer a range of vocational/skill training courses covering a large number of economic sectors with an objective to provide skilled workforce to the industry as well as self employment of youth. At present, there are 14,953 ITIs established across the country out of which 3,246 are Government aided ITIs and 11,707 are Private ITIs.

In the State of Tamil Nadu, there are total 501 ITIs (87 Government aided and 414 Private), which include nine Private ITIs at Mayiladuthurai, three Government aided and five Private ITIs at Nagapattinam. The details of the ITIs in the State of Tamil Nadu including Mayiladuthurai and Nagapattinam are placed at *Annexure-I*.

The details of the initiatives/programme undertaken by Ministry of Minority Affairs, Government of India for the development of entrepreneurial ecosystem are as follows:

(v) Pradhan Mantri Virasat Ka Samvardhan (PM VIKAS): The Ministry of Minority Affairs currently does not implement any specific scheme/ initiative targeted towards creating an entrepreneurial ecosystem especially in Tamil Nadu. However, the Ministry implemented various skill development schemes namely Seekho Aur Kamao',

'USTTAD', 'Nai Manzil', that have now been converged into an integrated scheme called 'Pradhan Mantri Virasat Ka Samvardhan (PM VIKAS)' for minority communities focusing on skill development; entrepreneurship and leadership of minority women; and education support for school dropouts. 1511 beneficiaries have been trained under these schemes in last five years in the State of Tamil Nadu.

- (b) Fund allocation for schemes during the last five years specifically for Tamil Nadu, year-wise is mentioned below:
- (i) Jan Shikshan Sansthan (JSS) Scheme: Each JSS is allocated annual Grantin-aid of Rs. 50 Lakh for conducting the training activities.

The total Grant-in-aid released to JSSs in the State of Tamil Nadu, year-wise are as under:

(ii) Pradhan Mantri Virasat Ka Samvardhan (PM VIKAS): 1511 beneficiaries have been trained under these schemes (Seekho Aur Kamao, USTTAD, Nai Manzil) in the last five years in the state of Tamilnadu. The schemes were implemented by the Ministry through Project Implementing Agencies (PIAS) empanelled under the schemes. State-wise fund allocation is not made. However, details of funds allocated for these schemes during last five years are given below:
