SCHEMES FOR PROMOTION OF TRIBAL CULTURE IN GUJARAT

†5175. Shri Jaswant Singh Bhabhor:

Will the Minister of CULTURE be pleased to state:

- a) the schemes implemented by the Government for the promotion of tribal culture, tribal museums, etc. in Gujarat along with the financial assistance provided for the said purpose;
- b) the institute-wise details of funds/grants provided to various organizations/institutions for the said purpose and the criteria for considering the proposals for grant of funds;
- c) whether the Government has received any requests/proposals from the Government of Gujarat to provide assistance to private institutions for the said purpose; and
- d) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF CULTURE, TOURISM AND DEVELOPMENT OF NORTH EASTERN REGION (SHRI G. KISHAN REDDY)

(a) and (b):

I. Government of India, Ministry of Culture operates a Museum Grant Scheme under which financial assistance is provided for setting up of new Museums and Development of existing museums including tribal museum by Centre/State Governments, Autonomous Bodies, Local Bodies, Academic Institutions, Public Sector Undertakings and Trusts registered under the Societies Act 1860 at Regional, State and District level. This scheme is applicable to all States and UTs including Gujarat. The proposals received in consonance with Museum Grant Scheme guidelines are considered for financial assistance. Year-wise details of the fund released under the Museum Grant Scheme for the state of Gujarat during the year 2020-21 to 2022-2023 is as follows:

Government of India has set up seven Zonal Cultural Centres (ZCCs) to protect, preserve and promote various forms of folk art and culture along with tribal culture in the country including Gujarat. The state of Gujarat comes under the purview of West Zone Culture Centre (WZCC) in Udaipur and the grant-in-aid released to WZCC during the last three years is as under:
