**MONITORING OF SCHEMES**

5187. MS. CHANDRANI MURMU:

Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has any mechanism to monitor the progress of various schemes launched by the ministry at the district level;
- (b) if so, the details of the progress made in the last five years across the country;
- (c) the details of boys and girls benefited under various schemes in Odisha, district-wise; and
- (d) the details of achievement of the schemes in the tribal areas of Odisha?

**ANSWER**

(a) and (b) Under Skill India Mission, the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) delivers Skill, Re-Skill and Up-Skill training programme to all the sections of the society, through an extensive network of skill development Centres/ Institutes across the country, under various schemes viz. Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY), Jan Shikshan Sansthan (JSS), National Apprenticeship Promotion Scheme (NAPS) and Craftsmen Training Scheme (CTS) through Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs).

The progress of the following schemes is monitored through the respective online web portals as per details given below:
