- (a) whether the Government has reduced the customs and the excise duties on various items after the announcement of demonetization;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor; and
- (c) the estimated shortfall in revenue in the financial year 2021-22 as a result thereof?

(a) to (c): Rates of customs and central excise duties are reviewed periodically as part of Union Budget exercise and otherwise, taking into account relevant factors including revenue, interest of domestic producers and user industry, export promotion etc. The revenue collection with respect to customs and central excise duties in FY 2021-22 has shown a growth vis-à-vis FY 2020-21.
