UNEMPLOYED YOUTH OF TRIBAL AREAS

5232. SHRI B.B.PATIL:

Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) whether any special measures have been taken by the Government so far to engage unemployed youths of tribal areas of the country in skill development programme;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; State/UT-wise; and
- (c) if not the reasons thereof?

ANSWER

(a) to (c) The Government has adopted a multi-pronged strategy for the overall development of tribal people living across the country which includes supports for skill training. The Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) delivers Skill, Re-Skill and Up-Skill training through an extensive network of skill development Centres / Institutes under various schemes viz. Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY), Jan Shikshan Sansthan (JSS), National Apprenticeship Promotion Scheme (NAPS) and Craftsmen Training Scheme (CTS) through Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs), to the youth belonging to all section of the society including tribal community. State/UT-wise total number of candidates and total ST candidates trained under PMKVY, JSS, NAPS and CTS are at Annexure-I, Annexure-II, Annexure-III and Annexure-IV respectively.

In addition to these Schemes, Ministry implemented Grameen Udyami pilot project, a unique multi-skilling project through National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC), aiming to augment skill training in tribal communities for their inclusive and sustainable growth. The Grameen Udyami project has been implemented in two States namely, Madhya Pradesh and Jharkhand. A total of 132 and 165 candidates have been certified in Madhya Pradesh and Jharkhand respectively.
