SKILL DEVELOPMENT CENTRES IN WEST BENGAL

**5249. DR. JAYANTA KUMAR ROY:
SHRIMATI SANGEETA KUMARI SINGH DEO:**

Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:-

- (a) the number of Skill Development Centres (SDCs) established in West Bengal including Jalpaiguri district and Odisha along with the funds allocated, centre-wise;
- (b) the details of courses offered under the Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) and number of students enrolled various courses;
- (c) whether any specific measures are adopted under PMKVY to increase participation of women in the training; and
- (d) the number of people employed through different courses of PMKVY from Jalpaiguri district of West Bengal and Balangir Constituency of Odisha?

ANSWER

(a) Under Skill India Mission, the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) delivers skill, Re-skill and Up-Skill training programme through an extensive network of Skill Development centres/ institutes across the country including West Bengal and Odisha under various schemes viz. Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY), Jan Shikshan Sansthan (JSS) Scheme and Craftsman Training Scheme (CTS) through Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs). The number of Skill Development centres/Institutions in the State of Odisha and West Bengal including Jalpaiguri district of West Bengal under PMKVY, JSS and ITI are given at **Annexure I**.

Under PMKVY, centre wise fund was not allocated, however; Rs. 449.08 crore and 324.32 Crore was utilized for imparting skill training in the State of West Bengal and Odisha respectively from 2015 to 31.12.2022. Under JSS scheme, Rs. 17.80 crore and Rs. 45.30 crore was released to the State of West Bengal and Odisha respectively from 2018-19 to 2022-23 (as on 15.02.2023). Day-to-day administration as well as financial control in respect of ITIs lies with the respective State Governments/Union Territory Administration.

(b) Under PMKVY since 2015, skill training has been imparted in 1440 job roles across various sectors and 1.43 crore candidates have been enrolled in these courses across the country as on 31.12.2022.

(c) Yes, Sir. To increase the participation of women under PMKVY additional benefits are extended to women trainees. Travelling allowance of Rs. 1,000.00 per candidate per month is provided if the Training Centre is situated within the district of domicile of the women candidate and Rs. 1,500.00 per month if the Training Centre is situated outside the district of domicile of the candidate. Post Placement Support is also provided to the women candidates at the rate of Rs. 1,500.00 per month per candidate for 2 months if candidate is placed within the district of domicile and the same is provided for 3 months in case the candidate is placed outside the district of domicile. Apart from this, residential training is also available for women trainees where boarding and lodging facility are provided as per Common Norms.

(d) Under the Short-Term Training component of PMKVY since 2015 to 31.12.2022, 4,664 and 5219 certified candidates have been reported placed in Jalpaiguri district of West Bengal and Balangir Constituency of Odisha respectively.
