**ORDER FOR NATIONAL FLAG**

5251. SHRI GAURAV GOGOI:

Will the Minister of CULTURE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Central Government had placed an order for handloom-national flag with Khadi Gram Udyog for 'Har Ghar Tiranga' programme;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (c) whether the Central Government had placed an order for handloom-national flag with any handloom weavers society other than Khadi Gramin Udyog for the programme;
- (d) if so, the details thereof ; and
- (e) if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) to (e): No Sir. The 'Har Ghar Tiranga' was a one- time campaign which required mass production of flags at very low cost so that common people of the country could afford to buy the National Flags. Ministry of Textiles facilitated adequate supply of the National Flags for 'Har Ghar Tiranga Campaign'. Six companies volunteered for production/dispatch of National Flags to all the States/Union Territories. Ministry of Textiles coordinated the production and dispatch of national Flags from these companies which volunteered, to the States/Union Territories.
