Will the Minister of CORPORATE AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of aggregate spending in the last seven years by the Public Sector Units (PSUs) and Non-Public Sector Units on Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR);
- (b) whether the Government has received any amount from PSUs and Non-PSUs for the development of villages and rural infrastructure;
- (c) if so, the details thereof;
- (d) whether the Government has any check and monitoring system to examine, if the CSR funds were spent genuinely for the said purposes, if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the amount received from Public Limited and Private Limited Companies for the same and the details of the expenditure incurred during the said period, State-wise?

(a): The broad framework for Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) has been provided under Section 135 of the Companies Act, 2013 ('Act'), Schedule VII of the Act and Companies (CSR Policy) Rules, 2014. All data related to CSR filed by companies in MCA21 registry is available in public domain and can be accessed at www.csr.gov.in. On the basis of annual filings made by Companies in the MCA21 registry, the aggregate CSR spent by Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs) and Non-PSUs during the financial year 2014-15 to 2020-21 are given below:

(b) & (c): Schedule VII of the Act indicates the eligible list of activities that can be undertaken by the companies as CSR. The Ministry vide General Circular no. 21/2014 dated 18th June, 2014 and 14/2021 dated 25th August, 2021 had clarified that items mentioned in Schedule VII are broad based and can be interpreted liberally. Item no. (x) of Schedule VII, covers "rural development" as eligible CSR activities. On the basis of filings made in the MCA21 registry, the aggregate CSR spent by PSUs and Non-PSUs in 'Rural Development' during the Financial Years (FY) 2014-15 to 2020-21 are given below:

(d): The CSR framework is disclosure based and CSR mandated companies are required to file details of CSR activities annually in the MCA21 registry. The corporate governance framework along with the existing legal provisions such as mandatory disclosures, accountability of the CSR Committee and the Board, provisions for statutory audit of accounts of the company etc. provide safeguards in this regard. Whenever any violation of CSR provisions is reported, action against such non-compliant companies are initiated as per provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 after due examination of records and following due process of law. Further, the amendments in the Companies (CSR Policy) Rules, 2014 notified on 22nd January 2021 have strengthened the CSR eco-system by bringing more objectivity, transparency, entrusting more responsibility on the Board and enlarging the disclosures by the companies.

(e): The details of CSR funds spent in 'Rural Development' sector by Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs) and Private companies, in different States /Union Territories (UTs) for the financial years 2014-15 to 2020-21 is at Annexure.
