- (b) if so, the details of employment and trades of different kinds related to textiles under the said programme including the State of Maharashtra;
- (c) whether the above programme are being implemented in different states including Maharashtra;
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (e) whether a decision has been taken to develop textile hubs in different States particularly in Maharashtra under this programme; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) to (d): Government is promoting employment and trade under the broad objective of Make- in India Programme catering to the Textile Sector through implementation of various schemes for overall promotion and development of Textiles Sector at Pan India level including the State of Maharashtra such as National Technical Textile Mission (NTTM), Silk Samagra-2, Scheme for Integrated Textile Park (SITP), National Handicraft Development Programme (NHDP), National Handloom Development Programme (NHDP) etc.

(e) & (f): With a view to attract investment, boost employment generation and position itself strongly in the global market, the Government has approved setting up of 7 (Seven) PM Mega Integrated Textile Region and Apparel (PM MITRA) Parks in Greenfield/Brownfield sites with world class infrastructure including plug and play facility with an outlay of Rs. 4,445 Cr. The Govt. has finalized 7 sites including one site in Amravati district, Maharashtra.
