STOPPAGE OF RAJDHANI EXPRESS AT GHAZIABAD

5337. SHRI ABDUL KHALEQUE:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is aware that a large number of people from North East resides in Noida and Ghaziabad districts of Uttar Pradesh, if so, the details thereof;**
- (b) whether the Government is considering to include Ghaziabad as a stoppage for Rajdhani Express from North East as this will reduce travel time for the people thus providing relief; and**
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor?**

(a) to (c) Presently, Ghaziabad is well connected by train services including those connecting it to the North Eastern part of the country. Further, provision of stoppages of train services, including Rajdhani Express services, is an on-going process on Indian Railways, subject to operational feasibility, commercial justification etc.
