Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has received proposals to release commemorative Postal Stamps on ancient personalities from various State Governments and Public representatives;
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the names of the said personalities;
- (c) the details of the action taken by the Government in this regard;
- (d) whether the Government proposes to release Postal Stamp in the name of a great Women Reformer, Padama Shri Awardee Dr. Sindhutai Sapkal who is also recognised as the Mother of Orphan children of the country; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI DEVUSINH CHAUHAN)

- (a) Yes sir. Department of Posts, from time to time, receives proposals to release Commemorative Postage Stamps on ancient personalities from various sources including State Governments and Public representatives.
- (b) & (c) The proposals to release Commemorative Postage Stamps are processed in the Department as per the laid down procedure. The Department of Posts, since independence, has issued 14 Commemorative Postage Stamps on ancient personalities. The list is **Annexed**.
- (d) & (e) There is no proposal under consideration to release a Commemorative Postage Stamp on Padma Shri Awardee Dr. Sindhutai Sapkal.
