### NATIONAL DIGITAL LITERACY MISSION

# 5436. SHRIMATI DELKAR KALABEN MOHANBHAI: SHRI GAJANAN KIRTIKAR: SHRI HEMANT TUKARAM GODSE:

Will the Minister of ELECTRONICS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY be pleased to state:

- (a) the year-wise details about number of people imparted Information and Technology (IT) training under National Digital Literacy Mission (NDLM) across various States of the country particularly in Dadra & Nagar Haveli, Daman & Diu and Maharashtra since the launch of the Mission;
- (b) the total number of Anganwadi workers, ASHA workers and Authorised Ration Distributors who have been imparted training in information and Technology (IT) literacy under the said scheme during the last five years, year and State/UT-wise;
- (c) the estimated time limit to achieve the target of ensuring digital literacy at least to one member from every family;
- (d) the effective measures being taken by the Government to achieve the said target; and
- (e) whether some villages of rural areas of the country are yet to get internet facilities and if so, the details thereof along with the number of such villages?

#### **ANSWER**

# MINISTER OF STATE FOR ELECTRONICS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (SHRI RAJEEV CHANDRASEKHAR)

- (a) to (c): To enhance digital adoption, Government is focusing on providing digital literacy to the citizens across the country. The steps taken by the Government to improve digital literacy among the urban and rural areas of the country given below:
- i. During the years 2014 to 2016, Government of India had implemented two Schemes on providing digital literacy to the masses namely "National Digital Literacy Mission (NDLM)" and "Digital Saksharta Abhiyan (DISHA)" with a cumulative target of 52.50 lakh persons (one person from every eligible household) across the country including rural India. Beneficiaries under the DISHA scheme also included field level government functionaries namely Anganwadi and ASHA workers and Authorised ration dealers in all the states across the country, the States/UTs -wise details is given as **Annexure-I**.

Under these two schemes, a total of 53.67 lakh beneficiaries were trained, out of which around 42% candidates were from rural India. Both schemes have been closed now. The State/UT-wise achievement is given as **Annexure-II**.

ii. In the year 2017, Government approved a Scheme titled "Pradhan Mantri Gramin Digital Saksharta Abhiyan (PMGDISHA)" to usher in digital literacy in rural India with a target to cover 6 crore rural households (one person per household) across the country. The scheme is under implementation and as of now, more than 6.82 crore candidates have been enrolled and 5.87 crore have been trained, out of which 4.37 crore candidates have been duly certified. The status of the scheme in the last five years is given below:

The State/UT-wise achievement under the PMGDISHA scheme is given as Annexure-II.

- (d): The following measures are taken up for achieving the targets under the PMGDISHA scheme:
- To ensure equitable geographical reach, each of the Gram Panchayat is envisaged to register an average of 200-300 candidates.
- The beneficiaries are provided with 20 hours of training consisting of 5 modules namely (i) Introduction to Digital Devices, (ii) Operating Digital Devices, (iii) Introduction to the Internet, (iv) Communications using the Internet, (v) Application of the Internet (includes Citizen centric services) and use of financial tools for undertaking digital cashless transactions.
- The training content is made available in 22 scheduled languages and English. This content is made available on both online and offline mode. In addition, keeping in view the thrust of the government on promoting cashless transactions through mobile phones, the content on digital wallets, mobile banking, Unified Payments Interface (UPI), Unstructured Supplementary Service Data (USSD), Aadhaar Enabled Payment System (AEPS), and PoS has also been included.
- After training of the candidate, a third-party Assessment of the trained candidates is carried out through online mode remotely proctored examination conducted by recognized Certifying Agencies namely National Institute of Electronics and Information Technology (NIELIT), National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS), Centre for Development of Advanced Computing (CDAC), Haryana Knowledge Corporation Limited (HKCL) and ICT Academy of Tamil Nadu (ICTACT). Digitally Signed Certificates are issued for all successful candidates and directly uploaded in their DigiLocker accounts.
- Awareness and promotional activities towards Digital literacy throughcampaigns, workshops, seminars, digital vans, etc.
- (e): Department of Telecommunication is implementing the BharatNet project in a phased manner to connect about 6 lakh inhabited villages including Gram Panchayats (GPs) with broadband facility in the country. As on date, total of 1,91,751 GPs have been made Service Ready under the BharatNet project in the country.
