**Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the railway line from Jaipur to Nathdwara via Todaraj Singh, Kekri Shahpura was approved and work was also started thereon, if so, the current status thereof;**
- (b) whether the work on the said railway line has been stopped;**
- (c) if so, the reasons therefor;**
- (d) whether there is any proposal to resume the work on the said railway route; and**
- (e) if so, the time by which it is likely to be resumed?**

**(a) Nathdwara is already connected with Jaipur by Railway Network via Ajmer and Marwar Junction and also via Ajmer, Chittaurgarh and Mavli Junction.**

**At present, no proposal for Jaipur-Nathdwara via Todaraisingh, Kekri and Shahpura New Line Project is under consideration.**

**However, a survey of new line between Mandalgarh-Todraisingh via Shahpura-Kekri (130 Km) has been taken up.**
