#### **UPGRADATION OF MAJOR TOURIST PLACES**

#### **547. SHRI JAGDAMBIKA PAL:**

Will the Minister of TOURISM be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to upgrade all major tourist places with the new technology;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (c) the details of the steps taken by the Government to make tourist places more attractive;
- (d) the number of domestic tourist visits in the country especially for the State of Uttar Pradesh;
- (e) whether the Government is developing spiritual tourism circuit in the country;
- (f) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (g) the details of the completion of the Ramayana, Mahabharat and Buddhist Circuits in the State of Uttar Pradesh?

#### **ANSWER**

#### THE MINISTER OF TOURISM

(SHRI G. KISHAN REDDY)

- (a) to (c): Development of tourism is primarily the responsibility of the State Governments/Union Territory Administrations. However, the Ministry of Tourism under its schemes of 'Swadesh Darshan' and 'National Mission on Rejuvenation and Spiritual, Heritage Augmentation Drive **Pilgrimage** (PRASHAD)' provides central financial assistance to State Governments/UT Administrations etc. for development of tourism infrastructure in the country and to provide complete tourism experience to the visitors. The Ministry of Tourism has now revamped its Swadesh Darshan scheme as Swadesh Darshan 2.0 (SD2.0) for development of sustainable and responsible tourist destinations. The guidelines of SD2.0 includes illustrative list of admissible components covering use of clean energy sources, renewable sources of energy for tourist infrastructure, access to clean technology, asset mapping, digital technologies and platforms, procurement of equipment for eco-friendly modes of tourist transport etc.
- (d): The details of the domestic tourist visits in the country including Uttar Pradesh is at annexure-I.
- (e) to (g): The Ministry of Tourism under the theme of Spiritual Circuit has sanctioned 13 projects, the detail of which is at annexure-II.
