**(a) The total revenue of the Indian Railways during FY 2021-22 and 2022-23 (upto Feb-2023) is ₹ 1,91,278.30 crore and ₹ 2,16,165.06 crore respectively.**

**(b) and (c) While station wise targets are not set, steps are taken for rationalization of revenues across Indian Railways. This is a continuous exercise and is done through various means including rationalization of fares & freight, monitoring of the passenger waitlist for attachment of additional coaches, operating special or new trains etc. To enhance freight revenue, Indian Railways is constantly in touch with customers. Its focus is on meeting the needs of freight in terms of timely availability, reliable service and proper handling of cargo.**

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
