(a) to (f): 'Make in India' is an initiative which was launched on 25th September, 2014 to facilitate investment, foster innovation, build best in class infrastructure, and make India a hub for manufacturing, design, and innovation. It is one of the unique 'Vocal for Local' initiatives that promoted India's manufacturing domain to the world. 'Make in India' initiative has significant achievements and presently focuses on 27 sectors including Textile and Apparels.

Government is promoting employment and businesses under the broad objective of Make- in-India Programme catering to various sub-sectors of the Textile Sector which includes Spinning, Weaving, Garmenting, Processing, Jute, Silk, Wool, Handicraft and Handloom.
