Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is aware of the fact that there are Post Offices, without a mobile network or internet connectivity especially in areas with difficult terrains and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the details of such Post Offices in the country, State-wise including Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh and Maharashtra:
- (c) the steps taken by the Government to ensure that network connectivity reaches such Post Offices; and
- (d) whether the Government has set any deadline for ensuring network connectivity in such areas and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI DEVUSINH CHAUHAN)

- (a) & (b) Yes, Sir. Government is aware of the fact that there are Post Offices, especially in areas with difficult terrains, without a mobile network or internet connectivity. At present, there are 879 Branch Post Offices which do not have mobile network or internet connectivity. State wise details of such Post Offices in the country, including Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh & Maharashtra are at **Annexure-I**.
- (c) & (d) Department of Posts has taken up the matter of providing connectivity to Post offices not having mobile network or internet connectivity with Department of Telecommunications.

As per cabinet approval dated 27.07.2022, under 4G saturation project total 24,680 uncovered villages across the country are proposed to be covered with 4 G services by Department of Telecommunications. Provision of 20% extra villages has also been kept. The project also includes upgradation to 4G service of existing 2G/3G sites at 6,279 villages. The project is to be completed by 09.12.2023.
