Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:-

- (a) the number of families which have been provided with tap connections under Har Ghar Nal Se Jal Yojana in the State of Gujarat;
- (b) the number of connections sanctioned in Gujarat; and
- (c) the number of beneficiaries in Gujarat under the said yojana, district-wise?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR JALSHAKTI (SHRI PRAHLAD SINGH PATEL)

(a) to (c) Since August, 2019, Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM), a centrally sponsored scheme, is being implemented in partnership with States, to make provision of potable tap water supply to every rural household of the country including those in Gujarat, on regular and long-term basis, by 2024. Prior to launch of JJM, 71.46 % of rural households in State were having tap water connection. As reported by State, since launch of JJM, 26.02 Lakhs rural households have been provided tap connections covering all 91.18 Lakh rural households in Gujarat, with a tap water connection.

The district wise number of beneficiaries provided with tap water connections under JJM, in terms of rural households in Gujarat State, is enclosed at **Annex**.
