- (b) the details of the works/projects completed under the CSR in Andhra Pradesh, district-wise and sector-wise;**
- (c) the number of beneficiaries of such CSR projects/works in Andhra Pradesh, district-wise; and**
- (d) the details and the names of the projects which have not been completed under CSR in Andhra Pradesh along with the reasons therefor?**

**(a) to (d): The broad framework for Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) has been provided under Section 135 of the Companies Act, 2013 ('Act'), Schedule VII of the Act and Companies (CSR Policy) Rules, 2014. All data related to CSR filed by companies in MCA21 registry is available in public domain at [www.csr.gov.in](http://www.csr.gov.in). However, the present CSR filing does not capture the beneficiary-wise details of the CSR projects of the companies. Further, completion status of CSR projects or activities are not maintained separately by the Government.**

**On the basis of the filings made by the companies in the MCA21 registry, State/UT-wise and Development sector-wise details of CSR spent by all the companies during last three Financial Years (FY) 2018-19, 2019-20 and 2020-21 are at Annexure - I & II respectively. Further, the District-wise and Development sector-wise CSR spent by all the companies in the state of Andhra Pradesh during last three FY 2018-19, 2019-20 and 2020-21 are at Annexure - III & IV respectively.**
