- (c) the details of activities carried out under the CSR fund in Uttar Pradesh?

(a) & (b): The broad framework for Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) has been provided under Section 135 of the Companies Act, 2013 ('Act'), Schedule VII of the Act and Companies (CSR Policy) Rules, 2014. The CSR framework is disclosure based and companies are required to file details of CSR activities annually in the MCA21 registry. All data related to CSR filed by companies in MCA21 registry is available in public domain at www.csr.gov.in.

On the basis of annual filings made by the Companies in the MCA21 registry, the CSR spent by the companies in the State of Uttar Pradesh during the last five Financial Years (FY) i.e. 2016-17, 2017-18, 2018-19, 2019-20 and 2020-21 respectively are given below:
