CONSTRUCTION OF UNDERPASS

72. SHRI KUMBAKUDI SUDHAKARAN:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has received representations/requests from public representatives seeking the construction of an underpass to facilitate the movement between Shri Oorpazhachi Kavu road at 161 km under Edakkad zone and NH-66 as part of the National Highways Developmental Project in Kannur and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Government has looked into the issue and conducted an inspection survey of the specified site;
- (c) if so, the details thereof and the actions taken by the Government in this regard; and
- (d) whether any directions have been given to the concerned authorities and contractors in this regard, if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI NITIN JAIRAM GADKARI)

(a) to (d) Yes Sir. A representation/reference was received for construction of Underpass at Edakkad at Km 160.820 in the project of 6 laning of Thaliparambha to Muzhapillangad section of National Highway (NH) - 66. The site was inspected and it is found that 2 Nos. of Light Vehicular Underpass (LVUP) are already proposed to be constructed at km 160.200 and km 162.360 which are 2 km apart from each other. Hence, construction of 1 more Underpass in between these 2 LVUPs is not justified as per Indian Road Congress (IRC) codal provisions.
