Will the Minister of SOCIAL JUSTICE AND EMPOWERMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of transgender persons benefitted through the Garima Greh Scheme, State-wise;
- (b) whether the Government has any proposal to extend the Scheme to all States;
- (c) if so, the proposed timeline thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (d) whether the Government has considered extending the benefits under the Scheme to the entire LGBTQIA+ community instead of transgender persons alone;
- (e) if so, the details and proposed timeline thereof; and
- (f) if not, the reasons therefor?

- (a): Department has setup 12 Garima Greh: Shelter Home for Transgender Persons on pilot basis in 9 States. In total, 654 transgender persons have benefited through Garima Greh project. State wise beneficiaries list is **annexed**.
- (b) & (c): Government aims to setup up more such Garima Grehs as per guidelines. This is a continuous process.
- (d) to (f): No Sir. There is no such proposal under consideration of the Ministry as Garima Greh has been designed specifically for Transgender Persons.
