OBJECTIVES OF SCHEMES

77. SHRI BASANTA KUMAR PANDA:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) the objectives of various schemes run by the Ministry and the number of beneficiaries in Odisha during the last eight years, district-wise;
- (b) the funds allocated by the Government to the State of Odisha during the last eight years;
- (c) whether the funds received by the Government of Odisha have been utilised; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES
(SHRI BHANU PRATAP SINGH VERMA)

(a): Ministry of MSME through its field offices network, implements various schemes/programmes for the promotion and development of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) sector across the country including the State of Odisha which inter alia include Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP), Micro and Small Enterprises-Cluster Development Programme (MSE-CDP), Scheme of Fund for Regeneration of Traditional Industries (SFURTI), Credit Guarantee Scheme for Micro and Small Enterprises (CGTMSE), A Scheme for Promotion of Innovation, Rural Industries and Entrepreneurship (ASPIRE), Entrepreneurship and Skill Development Programme (ESDP), National Schedule Caste and Schedule Tribe Hub (NSSH) etc. Objectives of these schemes inter alia include facilitating easy credit access, market access, technological support to MSMEs and developing entrepreneurship attitude/skill among the youth towards generating self-employment opportunities.

The Government has taken a number of recent initiatives to support MSMEs in the country including the State of Odisha, which inter alia include:

- (i) Rs. 5 lakh crore Collateral Free Automatic Loans for business, including MSMEs.
- (ii) Rs. 50,000 crore equity infusion through MSME Self-Reliant India Fund.
- (iii) New revised criteria for classification of MSMEs.
- (iv) No global tenders for procurement up to Rs. 200 crores.
- (v) "Udyam Registration" for MSMEs, for Ease of Doing Business.
- (vi) Launching of an online Portal "Champions" in June, 2020 to cover many aspects of e-governance including grievance redress and handholding of MSMEs.
- (vii) Inclusion of Retail and Wholesale trades as MSMEs w.e.f. 02nd July, 2021.
- (viii) Non-tax benefits extended for 3 years in case of an upward change in status of MSMEs.
- (ix) Roll out of Raising and Accelerating MSME Performance (RAMP) programme with an outlay of Rs. 6,000 crore over 5 years.
- (x) Launching of "Udyam Assist Platform" (UAP) on 11th January, 2023 for bringing Informal Micro Enterprises (IMEs) under the formal ambit.

District-wise beneficiaries in the State of Odisha during the last eight years under major schemes of the Ministry such as PMEGP and CGTMSE are given at Annexure-I and Annexure-II, respectively. District-wise number of MSMEs registered on 'Udyog Aadhaar Memorandum' portal (from 18.09.2015 to 30.06.2020) and on the 'Udyam Registration' portal (from 01.07.2020 to 27.01.2023) in the State of Odisha are given at Annexure-III.

(b) to (d): Schemes of the Ministry of MSME are Central Sector Schemes where funds are not allocated State/UT-wise.
