**HOUSES TO POOR AND BPL PEOPLE**

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of houses built under the Indira Awas Yojana (IAY) for the people living below poverty line and poor families from the year 2004 to 2014, State, district and year-wise particularly in Mangaldoi Parliamentary Constituency of Assam in North East, Chatra Parliamentary Constituency of Jharkhand and Bilaspur Parliamentary Constituency of Chhattisgarh;
- (b) the total number of houses built under Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana - Gramin (PMAY-G) from the year 2014 till now in each district of the country, State-wise including Assam and Jharkhand along with Bilaspur, Mungeli and Gaurela-Pendra-Marwahi districts of Chhattisgarh;
- (c) whether according to the 2011 census data, out of 20.6 crore houses in rural areas, about 20.7 per cent houses still have kutcha roofs and if so, the details thereof;
- (d) whether the IAY has not achieved its long term desired goal since 1985 till date and if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor; and
- (e) the amount of funds spent and the number of houses built thereunder in Chhattisgarh, district-wise?

**ANSWER**

- (a) A total number of 2,10,48,638 Houses had been constructed under Indira Awas Yojana (IAY) from the year 2004-2014. State/District-wise data of houses constructed under IAY is not maintained in the Ministry.
- (b) The State-wise details of House built under PMAY-G from the year 2014 to 2022-23 (as on 03.02.2023) is given in **Annexure-I**. The District/Block/Gram Panchayat level data of all States/UTs related to houses allocated, sanctioned and completed can be seen at Programme website at [www.pmayg.nic.in](http://www.pmayg.nic.in)---->AwaasSoft---->Reports---->Houses progress against the financial year.
- (c) & (d) As per Census 2011, 3.47 crore rural families are either houseless or live in houses of temporary nature. As per Socio-Economic Caste Census (SECC-2011) data, 4.04 crore rural households are either houseless or living in zero or one/two room kutcha houses. The data of 4.04 crore households derived from SECC was sent to States/UTs for conducting Gram Sabha verification and Appellate Process. After exclusion of ineligible households by

Gram Sabha and due appellate process, 2.95 crore households were found eligible for providing assistance under PMAY-G. Accordingly, the overall target of 2.95 crore households was set under the scheme.

A total of 75,44,788 pending IAY houses in various States/UTs have been completed since 2014 besides completion of 2.15 crore PMAY-G houses since 1<sup>st</sup> April 2016.

(e) A total of 3,12,105 houses have been constructed under IAY in the State of Chhattisgarh from the year 2009-10 to 2022-23. The district wise details of the IAY is not maintained in the Ministry.
