AWARDS SCHEMES UNDER PMAY-G

808. SHRI A. GANESHAMURTHI:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether any target has been fixed for construction of number of houses under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana-Gramin (PMAY-G);
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the amount of funds allocated and spent during the last three years and in the current year, State-wise;
- (c) whether any monitoring committee has been formed to review the progress of construction of houses in various States under the said yojana and if so, the details thereof;
- (d) whether any award schemes have been launched for the best performing States/UTs in the construction of houses and achieving the targets; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SADHVI NIRANJAN JYOTI)

(a) In order to achieve the target of "Housing for All" in rural areas, the Ministry of Rural Development is implementing Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana- Gramin (PMAY-G) with effect from 1stApril, 2016 to provide assistance to eligible rural households with an overall target to construct 2.95 crore pucca houses with basic amenities by March, 2024.

(b) The details of Central Share released and utilized by the States under PMAY-G during the last three years and in the current year are given in **Annexure**.

(c) Performance monitoring of PMAY-G is done through real time capture of progress using workflow enabled transactional data in MIS i.e.AwaasSoft and dedicated analytic dashboard for micro monitoring. For process monitoring mechanisms such as Performance Review Committee (PRC) meeting with States/UTs, inspections by central teams [Area Officers and National Level Monitors (NLM)], monitoring by District Development Coordination and Monitoring (DISHA) Committee headed by Member of Parliament, Social Audit, etc., exist.

The National Level Monitoring system of Ministry of Rural Development is a third party monitoring and reporting mechanism working towards regular assessment of implementation of Rural Development Programmes/ Schemes including PMAY-G in the country.

(d) & (e) The Ministry has taken several initiatives to ensure timely completion of the houses under PMAY-G, inter alia, conferring awards to the best performing States/UTs, performance index dashboard, thereby creating healthy competition and motivation among the States/UTs for achieving the set targets.
