Accountability of National Sporting Federations

813. SHRI ANUBHAV MOHANTY:

Will the Minister of YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government plans to introduce a strong Sports Law that will govern every National Sporting Federations in the country considering the recent ban on All India Football Federation by FIFA, followed by warning to Indian Olympic Association by the International Olympic Committee;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) whether the Government has any proposal to establish an autonomous body that will supervise various aspects of sports associations including elections, administrative functions and dispute mechanism;

(d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;

(e) the details of any other steps taken by the Government to ensure accountability of National Sporting Federations in the country; and

(f) the details of grants given to various National Sporting Federations?

**ANSWER
THE MINISTER OF YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS
(SHRI ANURAG SINGH THAKUR)**

(a) to (e): No, Sir. Governance and management of National Sports Federations (NSFs) is, at present, regulated in terms of the National

Sports Development Code of India 2011 (“The Sports Code”), which is an amalgamation of instructions and guidelines brought out by the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports. Provisions of the Sports Code are legally binding, as upheld by the Courts of Law.

Under the Sports Code, the Ministry ensures that recognised NSFs abide by the basic and cardinal principles, such as age & tenure restrictions in respect of office bearers of the NSFs, conduct off air and transparent elections, protection of athletes’ interests, etc. The Government insists on observance of the provisions of the Sports Code by the NSFs to maintain their recognition on an year-to-year basis. Wherever any such violations are noticed, necessary action including suspension and withdrawal of recognition is taken.

(f) The details of grants given to the various NSFs during the last three financial years are at Annexure.
