823. SHRI ARJUN LAL MEENA:

Will the Minister of FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING मत्स्यपालन, पशुपालनऔरडेयरीमंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) the measures being taken by the Government to upgrade Swachh Dugdh Utpadan Karyakram Yojana and Rashtriya Dairy Vikas Yojana;
- (b) the reasons for giving clearance to the said schemes under National Livestock Mission, Sub-Mission on Feed and Fodder Development;
- (c) the facilities provided by the Government to farmers to promote dairy project; and
- (d) the details of work done so far for welfare and upliftment of farmers and residents of tribal areas under Rashtriya Dairy Vikas Yojana and NABARD in Udaipur Lok Sabha Constituency?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER FOR FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING (SHRI PARSHOTTAM RUPALA)

- (a)& (b) National Programme for Dairy Development (NPDD) was launched in February 2014 by merging three existing schemes i.e. Intensive Dairy Development Programme, Strengthening Infrastructure for Quality & Clean Milk Production and Assistance to Cooperatives. In July 2021, NPDD has been restructured with the aim of enhancing quality of milk and milk products and increasing the share of organised procurement, processing, value addition and marketing; for implementation from 2021-22 to 2025-26. National Livestock Mission, Sub-Mission on Feed and Fodder Development is a separate scheme aiming to increase availability of fodder and feed.
- (c) Supplementing the efforts of the State Government, Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying has been implementing the following dairy development schemes:
 - i. National Programme for Dairy Development
 - ii. Dairy Processing and Infrastructure Development Fund
 - iii. Supporting Dairy Cooperatives and Farmer Producer Organisations engaged in dairy activities

The above schemes benefit farmer-members, including financially weaker farmers in the dairy sector.

(d) Under NPDD scheme, 2 projects has been approved in Udaipur (Udaipur Dudh Utpadak Sahakari Sangh Limited) with the total project cost of Rs.1278.67 lakh with a central share of Rs.957.32 lakh and out of this an amount of Rs. 957.32 lakh has been released. The project has assisted in creation of additional 50 thousand litres milk processing capacity, installation of 115 Automatic Milk Collection Units and 114 Electronic Milk Adulteration Testing Machines.

Besides the above, subsidy was channelized through NABARD under Dairy Entrepreneurship Development Scheme (DEDS) and National Livestock Mission (NLM) schemes. The details of subsidy released by NABARD under these schemes in Udaipur district are as under:-
