LUMPY SKIN DISEASE

866. SHRIMATI APARAJITA SARANGI: SHRI HANUMAN BENIWAL:

Will the Minister of FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING मत्स्यपालन, पशुपालनऔरडेयरीमंत्री be pleased to state?

- (a) whether the Government is aware of large number of deaths of the bovines due to the Lumpy Skin disease in various States including Odisha and Rajasthan;
- (b) if so, the total number of bovines, cows and other animals who died due to the said disease, State-wise including Odisha and Rajasthan;
- (c) the places where lumpy disease was first detected in other livestock including cows in the country, State-wise including Odisha;
- (d) whether the Government has allocated funds to the farmers and cattle owners affected by lumpy skin disease, if so, the details thereof and the total funds allocated in this regard, State-wise including Odisha;
- (e) whether the Government plans to invest in research and development towards development of a vaccine to prevent lumpy skin disease, if so, the details of investment made and roadmap to launch such a vaccine; and
- (f) whether the Government has issued any guidelines to the State Governments to prevent from above lumpy disease in the country and if so, the details thereof, State-wise including Odisha?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER FOR FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING (SHRI PARSHOTTAM RUPALA)

- (a) and (b): Yes, Sir. The details of cattle deaths are attached at Annexure 1.
- (c): Lumpy Skin Disease was reported in cattle initially from Odisha in September, 2019. The details of places are attached at **Annexure 1**
- (d): Animal Husbandry is a State subject. Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Government of India do not have any scheme to allocate the funds to the farmers and cattle owners affected by lumpy Skin disease. However, Department is taking all necessary steps to support States / UTs to control and contain the disease which include financial and technical support. The details of funds released/permission accorded to States/UTs to utilize funds from available central share for procurement of vaccine is attached at **Annexure 2.**
- (e): As gathered from Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR), a homologous live attenuated Lumpy Skin Disease vaccine for use in cattle and buffaloes has been developed by ICAR. The vaccine technology has since been released by ICAR to M/s. Indian Immunological Limited, Hyderabad and M/s. Biovet Private Limited, Malur, Karnataka, and the vaccine is in the testing stage before its commercial production.
- (f): Department of Animal Husbandry & Dairying, Government of India has issued guidelines/advisories for control of LSD including vaccination and treatment and circulated them to States / UTs, including Odisha, to control and contain the disease.
