**DDU-GKY IN BIHAR**

903. SHRI AJAY NISHAD:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY) is being implemented by the Government in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise including Bihar;
- (c) whether the youths of rural areas of Muzaffarpur and Vaishali are being imparted training under the said yojana;
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (e) the number of the youths who have been imparted training and who got employment on completion of their training?

**ANSWER**

(a) Yes Sir, Deen Dayal Upadhyay-Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY) is being implemented across the country including Bihar.

(b) DDU-GKY is a placement linked skill development program for rural poor youth in the age group of 15-35 years and is being implemented by the Government since September, 2014. DDU-GKY guidelines provide for earmarking 50% of the funds for SCs and STs and 15% for minorities. Further, 1/3 beneficiaries of the respective categories under the scheme should be women.

DDU-GKY follows 3-tier implementation architecture for implementation. National level is responsible for policy, funding of central share and technical support, while State Rural Livelihood Missions (SRLMs)/ State Skills Missions are responsible for funding of State share, implementation and monitoring controls. Project Implementing Agencies (PIAs), which are mostly private training partners, are responsible for mobilization, training and placements.

Details of candidates trained & placed under DDU-GKY, State-wise including Bihar State, during the last three years and current financial year is given at **Annexure-I**

(c)&(d) Yes Sir, the youth of rural areas of Muzaffarpur and Vaishali, who fulfill the eligibility criteria, are being imparted skill training. District wise details of youths trained and placed is not maintained in the Ministry of Rural Development. However, as per information received from the State Government, 4068 candidates have been trained and 2146 candidates have been placed in Muzaffarpur district and 3089 candidates have been trained and 1508 candidates have been placed in Vaishali district under DDU-GKY since inception.

(e) Under DDU GKY, a total of 1330526 candidates have been imparted training and 800838 candidates have been placed on completion of their training till 31.12.2022 since inception.
