**Sports Projects in Ladakh**

**906. SHRI JAMYANG TSERRING NAMGYAL:**

**Will the Minister of YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS be pleased to state:**

- (a) the details of ongoing sport projects, facilities and opportunities being provided in Union Territory of Ladakh;**
- (b) the details of construction of indoor stadium and multipurpose stadium, ice hockey ring, playground, facilities of sports equipments and the funds allocated for both town and rural villages;**
- (c) the steps taken/being taken by the Government to provide higher level training and to encourage State and National level players; and**
- (d) the details of various programmes through which the Government extends sports facilities in the Union Territory of Ladakh?**

**(a) & (b) The details of sports infrastructure projects sanctioned along with the funds allocated, under Khelo India Scheme, in the Union Territory of Ladakh are at Annexure.**

**(c) & (d) 'Sports' being a State subject, the responsibility to promote and develop sports in the country, rests primarily with the respective State/Union Territory Governments. The Union Government supplements**

**their efforts. However, the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports (MYAS) implements the following schemes for the development of sports in the country:**

**(i) Khelo India- National Programme for Development of Sports; (ii) Assistance to National Sports Federations; (iii) Special Awards to Winners in International Sports Events and their Coaches; (iv) National Sports Awards; (v) Pension to Meritorious Sportspersons; (vi) Pandit Deendayal Upadhyay National Sports Welfare Fund; (vii) National Sports Development Fund; and (viii) Running Sports Training Centres through Sports Authority of India.**

**Details of the above schemes are available in the public domain on the websites of this Ministry and the Sports Authority of India.**

**Further, Sports Authority of India (SAI) has established 23 National Centres of Excellence (NCoE) across the Country to impart specialized training to promising athletes, including State and National level players, from across the country, including from the Union Territory of Ladakh, by providing state of the art infrastructure and training facilities, sports science backup, individualized diet prescribed by trained nutritionists with overall supervision of the best coaches and qualified support staff.**
