DAY-NRLM IN ODISHA

920. SHRIMATI SANGEETA KUMARI SINGH DEO:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of Women Self Help Groups which have been assisted in Odisha under Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana - National Rural Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NRLM);
- (b) the details of funds allocated, released and utilised so far in Odisha for implementation of DAY-NRLM during the last five years;
- (c) the details of funds regarding Revolving Fund, Community Investment Fund, Salary of Community Resource Person and interest subsidy for loan under the scheme in Odisha, year-wise; and
- (d) the other steps being taken by the Government in this regard?

ANSWER

(a) The Ministry is implementing Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana – National Rural Livelihoods Mission (DAY – NRLM) across the country (except Delhi & Chandigarh) with the objective of organizing the rural poor women into Self Help Groups (SHGs) and continuously nurturing and supporting them till they attain appreciable increase in incomes over a period of time and improve their quality of life and come out of abject poverty. As on 31st January 2023, 54.31 lakh women from rural households have been mobilised into 5.27 lakh Self Help Groups (SHGs) in Odisha State under DAY-NRLM.

(b) The details of Central funds allocated, released and utilised in Odisha for implementation of DAY-NRLM during the last five years is as below:

(d) Other steps taken by the Ministry under DAY-NRLM in odisha State are as under :

i) Social Security:

In order to protect SHG members from various vulnerabilities, the Mission facilitates to cover SHG members under relevant social security schemes. As on 31st January 2023, 45.80 Lakh SHG members have been covered under Pradhan Mantri Suraksha Bima Yojana (PMSBY), 29.06 Lakh SHG members have been covered under Pradhan Mantri Jeevan Jyoti Bima Yojana (PMJJBY) and 40.30 Lakh SHG members have been covered under Biju Swasthya Kalyan Yojana(State Government health scheme) .

ii) Farm Livelihood interventions:

- The Mission promotes sustainable agriculture practices to enhance crop productivity by providing training and capacity building of SHGs members involved in farming. As on 31st January 2023, 18.21 lakh women farmers from SHGs ecosystem have been covered under this intervention.
- Agri Nutri Garden:11.61 Lakh households have been facilitated for promotion of Agri Nutri Garden

iii) Non-Farm Livelihood :

Start Up Village Entrepreneurship Programme (SVEP), the sub-scheme under the Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana - National Rural Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NRLM) supports the Self-Help Group (SHG) or their family members to set-up small enterprises in the non-farm sector. In Odisha, SVEP is being implemented in 12 blocks - Angul, Bhograi, Bangomunda, Badamba, Rangeilunda, Danagadi, Mahakalapada, Morada, Umerkote, Ranapur, Sadar, Kuarmunda. Till 31st December, 2022, a total of 12,910 enterprises have been supported under the SVEP scheme.
