**Repair of Schools under Samagra Shiksha Scheme/Swachh Bharat Vidyalaya**

\*148. SHRIMATI SUPRIYA SULE:

DR. AMOL RAMSING KOLHE:

Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is true that the Samagra Shiksha Scheme supports expenditure on major repairs in schools for better functionality;
- (b) if so, the details of expenditure shared by the Government under Samagra Shiksha Scheme in schools of Maharashtra, Odisha, Tamil Nadu and Andaman and Nicobar Islands during the last three years and in the current year;
- (c) the number of schools in which repair work was carried out and infrastructure facilities augmented in Maharashtra, Tamil Nadu, Odisha and Andaman and Nicobar Islands;
- (d) whether the Government has also set any target to construct toilets in schools under Swachh Bharat Vidyalaya campaign and if so, the number of toilets constructed;
- (e) whether the set targets for the campaign have been achieved and if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor, State/UT-wise;
- (f) the status of construction of toilets for women and girls in schools along with the time frame set for making those accessible to them, State-wise/UT-wise; and
- (g) the other steps taken by the Government to provide good infrastructure and other basic facilities including clean drinking water and toilets to students studying in Government schools?

**Statement referred to in reply to parts (a) to (g) of Lok Sabha Starred Question No. 148 answered on 31<sup>st</sup> July, 2023 asked by Hon'ble MPs Shrimati Supriya Sule and Dr. Amol Ramsing Kolhe regarding Repair of Schools under Samagra Shiksha Scheme/Swachh Bharat Vidyalaya**

(a) & (b): Yes Sir. The Department of School Education & Literacy, Ministry of Education is implementing Samagra Shiksha from 2018-19 to support States and UTs for strengthening of existing government schools and for creation and augmentation of infrastructure facilities, including the component of major repair, based on the gaps determined from Unified District Information System for Education (UDISE+) and proposals received from respective State/UT. The need for schools and also the infrastructural facilities in schools are worked out every year by the respective State/Union Territory on incremental basis depending on their need and priority and reflected in their Annual Work Plan & Budget (AWP&B). These plans are then appraised and approved/estimated by the Project Approval Board (PAB) in the Department of School Education & Literacy in consultation with the States and UTs.

The details of Central Share allocated to Maharashtra, Odisha, Tamil Nadu and Andaman and Nicobar Islands for carrying out major repair works in schools during the last three years and in the current year upto June, 2023 is at **Annexure-I**.

(c): The details of repair work carried out and infrastructure facilities augmented in Odisha, Tamil Nadu, Maharashtra and Andaman and Nicobar Islands under Samagra Shiksha is at **Annexure-II**.

(d) & (e): The State wise details of toilets constructed in schools under the Swachh Vidyalaya Initiative and status of completion is at **Annexure-III**.

(f): The State/UT wise status of construction of separate toilets for girls in schools under Samagra Shiksha is at **Annexure-IV**.

(g): Education is in the Concurrent list of Constitution and most of the schools come under jurisdiction of concerned States and UTs. State and UT Governments are the appropriate Governments under the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education (RTE) Act, 2009, and have the responsibility and mandate to provide school infrastructure in schools in accordance with the norms laid down in the Schedule to the RTE Act, 2009 and as per respective State RTE Rules.

The States/UTs have been repeatedly advised in various forums including Project Approval Board (PAB) meeting, review PABs for filling up the gaps in school infrastructure and ensure that all the schools in their jurisdiction have provision for separate toilets for boys and girls and safe and adequate drinking water facilities for all children. The States/UTs have also been requested to converge the various components of Samagra Shiksha with the schemes of other Ministries for filling up the gaps in school infrastructure.

The Department of School Education & Literacy has approved a project on Rejuvenation of Basic Infrastructure and overall cleanliness in Government schools in approximately 1.20 lakh Government schools across the country with an overall budget estimate of Rs. 4590 crore under Samagra Shiksha scheme. The interventions covered under the project are major/minor repairs, functional toilets (boys/girls), electricity connections, functional drinking water facility and boundary walls. The objective is to fill up infrastructure gaps in government schools across the country through Samagra Shiksha and convergence with all relevant schemes of Government of India. Further, a joint advisory to all States/UTs has been issued on 19.12.2022 by NITI Aayog, Ministry of Education, Ministry of Rural Development, Ministry of Panchayati Raj and Ministry of Jal Shakti regarding rejuvenation of basic infrastructure including improved sanitation facilities and provision of safe drinking water in schools.
