(a) to (c): Development of tourism infrastructure in a State/Union Territory is primarily the responsibility of the concerned State Government/ Union Territory Administration, however, Ministry of Tourism (MoT) under its 'Swadesh Darshan', 'Pilgrimage Rejuvenation and Spiritual Heritage Augmentation Drive' (PRASHAD) and 'Assistance to Central Agencies' Schemes provides financial assistance to the State Governments/ Union Territory Administrations/Central Agencies for development of infrastructure at tourist destinations including at religious/pilgrimage sites. Based on the proposal received as per the scheme guidelines, MoT has sanctioned 6 projects under PRASHAD Scheme and 9 projects under Swadesh Darshan Scheme in the state of Uttar Pradesh including 2 projects covering development work at Kushinagar, details of which is given below:
