NO. 206. SHRI HIBI EDEN:

Will the Minister of Housing & Urban Affairs be pleased to state:

- (a) the objectives and major components of the National Urban Livelihoods Mission (NULM) project implemented in Kochi Municipal Corporation and municipalities of Ernakulam district;**
- (b) whether the government has data or reports on the self-employment programmes facilitated by the NULM project in the region and if so, the details thereof;**
- (c) the support and welfare initiatives provided to urban street vendors as part of the NULM project in the area;**
- (d) whether the Government has allocated sufficient funds for the implementation of the projects under NULM in Kochi Municipal Corporation and municipalities of Ernakulam district during the last three financial years and the current financial year; and**
- (e) if so, the details thereof, ULB-wise?**

STATEMENT

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. *206 FOR ANSWER ON 03.08.2023 REGARDING "NULM PROJECT IN KOCHI AND ERNAKULAM"

- (a):** Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs (MoHUA) is administering a Centrally Sponsored Scheme named "Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana- National Urban Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NULM), through the respective States/UTs, to reduce poverty and vulnerability of urban poor households on a sustainable basis. As informed by the State Government of Kerala, Social Mobilization and Institution Development (SM&ID), Employment through skills Training and Placement (EST&P), Self-Employment Programme (SEP), Scheme for Shelter for Urban Homeless (SUH) and Support to Urban Street Vendors (SUSV) components of DAY-NULM are being implemented in Kochi Municipal Corporation and other municipalities of Ernakulam district.
- (b) & (c):** As informed by the State Government of Kerala, under the SEP component (as on 25.07.2023), loans with the provision of interest subvention have been disbursed to 1,303 beneficiaries for self-employment through individual or group micro-enterprises and 4,266 loans have been disbursed under SHG Bank Linkage Programme in Ernakulam district. Under the SUSV component, 4,582 Street Vendors have been identified in survey in 14 Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) of Ernakulam district, out of which, Certificate of Vending and Identity cards have been issued to 2,887 and 3,649 street vendors respectively. Further, 72 vending zones have been identified and 1 vending market has been developed in Ernakulam district.
- (d) & (e):** Funds under DAY-NULM are released to States/ UTs for all its components as a whole. Inter-se allocation of funds for different components is made by States/ UTs. During last three financial years and the current financial year upto 30.06.2023, ₹ 92.51 crores Central assistance has been released to the State Government of Kerala under the scheme. District/ULB-wise central assistance released is not maintained at the level of MoHUA. However, as per information provided by the State Government of Kerala, the ULB-wise details of funds allocated under DAY-NULM in Ernakulam district during last three financial years and the current financial year is at Annexure-I.
