#### **STATEMENT**

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 214 FOR 03.08.2023 REGARDING "MANAGEMENT OF GARBAGE, WASTE AND SEWAGE"

- (a) : The aim of launching the National Capacity Building
  Framework for Garbage Free Cities under Swachh Bharat
  Mission-Urban (SBM-U 2.0) is:
  - i. To augment the capacity and skills of the existing cadre of officials at State and ULBs
- ii. To strategically engage specialized human resource at the State and ULB level to enhance the effectiveness and efficiency of Mission implementation
- iii. To strengthen ecosystem and institutionalizing capacity building of States and ULBs through Centre of Excellence and Swachhta Knowledge Partners (SKPs)

Details of the funds allocated and utilized in respect of National Capacity Building Framework to achieve garbage free cities by States/UTs under SBM-U 2.0 is at Annexure-I.

(b): The following measures have been taken/are being taken by the Government to make cities Garbage Free:

- i. Strengthened focus on 100% door to door collection of segregated waste from each household.
- ii. Implementing segregation of waste at source of generation of waste.
- iii. Creating facilities for 100% scientific management of all fractions of waste such as Dry, Wet, Construction & Demolition waste.
- iv. Enhanced focus on remediation of all legacy waste dump sites. MoHUA has approved remediation of 1,785 dumpsites for processing of 17.60 crore MT of legacy waste. The approved Central Financial Assistance for remediation of legacy waste dumpsites is Rs. 3469 crore so far.

- v. Awareness creation along with large scale citizen outreach to create Jan-Andolan and institutionalize Swachh Behaviour.
- vi. All the cities have been encouraged to identify their gaps and prepare City Sanitation Action Plans, City Solid Waste Action Plans, Used Water Management Plans and IEC and Capacity Building Plans.
- vii. Swachh Bharat Mission Urban 2.0 is being implemented with financial allocation of Rs. 1, 41,678 Cr. over a period of 5 years 2021-26. The State wise allocation of funds under SBM-U 2.0 is at Annexure-II
