- (b) if so, the guidelines, course duration and syllabus prescribed for the said programme;
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor;
- (d) whether the Allopathy nurses will also be able to enroll themselves for the said degree programme; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 227 FOR 4TH AUGUST, 2023

(a) to (c) Indian Nursing Council has notified one year Post Basic Diploma in Ayurveda Nursing Residency Programme on 22.02.2023. The Post Basic Diploma in Ayurveda Speciality Nursing – Residency Program is a one-year residency program having focus on competence-based training. It is designed to train registered nurses (GNM or B.Sc.) with specialized knowledge, skills and attitude in providing quality Ayurveda nursing care to patients. The syllabus broadly includes concepts, principles and standards of Ayurveda Nursing practice.

Further, B.Sc (N) syllabus has been revised vide notification dated 05.07.2021 to include aspects of AYUSH in various semesters of B.Sc (N) under different subjects.

(d) & (e) Registered nurses (GNM/B.Sc (N) are eligible to apply for Post Basic Diploma in Ayurveda Nursing-Residency programme.
