*237. SHRI JANARDAN SINGH SIGRIWAL: SHRI VIJAY KUMAR:

Will the Minister of AYUSH be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of Ayurveda colleges and hospitals established under the National AYUSH Mission in the country since the inception of Mission, State/UT-wise including Bihar;
- (b) the number of Primary Health Centres, Community Health Centres and District Hospitals providing AYUSH treatment facilities, State/UT-wise including Bihar;
- (c) whether funds are provided by the Government to Ayurveda colleges for development in the country;
- (d) if so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise, district-wise including Bihar and if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (e) the steps taken/proposed to be taken by the Government to ensure availability of quality AYUSH medicines at affordable prices in the country?

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 237* FOR 4TH AUGUST, 2023

- (a) Public Health being a State subject, the primary responsibility to establish Ayurveda colleges and hospitals in the country lies with the respective State/UT Governments including Bihar. However, under Centrally Sponsored Scheme of the National Ayush Mission (NAM), there is a provision of financial assistance to States/UTs for establishment of new Ayush colleges including Ayurveda system in the States where availability of Ayush teaching institutions is inadequate in Government Sector and setting up of upto 10/30/50 Bedded Integrated Ayush Hospitals including Ayurveda system. Accordingly, State/UT Governments may avail financial assistance by submitting suitable proposal through State Annual Action Plans (SAAPs) as per the provision of the NAM guidelines. Further, as per the proposals received from the State/UT Governments including Bihar, the State/UT-wise list of approved new Ayurveda colleges and Integrated Ayush Hospitals is furnished at **Annexure-I.**
- (b) The number of Primary Health Centres (PHCs), Community Health Centres (CHCs) and District Hospitals (DHs) providing Ayush treatment facilities, State/UT-wise including Bihar is furnished at **Annexure-II.**
- (c) & (d) Under NAM, there is provision of financial assistance to States/UTs for infrastructural development/up gradation of Ayush including Ayurveda Under-Graduate Institutions and Post-Graduate Institutions. As per the proposals received from the State/UT Governments including Bihar, the State/UT-wise status of funds approved for Ayurveda colleges is furnished at **Annexure-III**.
- (e) Ministry of Ayush has implemented Central Sector Scheme AYUSH Oushadhi Gunvatta Evam Uttpadan Samvardhan Yojana (AOGUSY) was approved by Standing Finance Committee (SFC) on 16.03.2021. The total financial allocation to this scheme is Rs. 122.00 crores for five years. The components of scheme are as under:
 - A. Strengthening and up-gradation of Ayush Pharmacies and Drug Testing Laboratories to achieve higher standards.
 - B. Pharmacovigilance of ASU &H drugs including surveillance of misleading advertisements.
 - C. Strengthening of Central and State regulatory frameworks including Technical Human Resource & Capacity Building programs for Ayush drugs.
 - D. Support for development of standards and accreditation/certification of Ayush products & materials in collaboration with Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS), Quality Control of India (QCI) and other relevant scientific institutions and industrial Research & Development Centres.
