- (a) whether the Central Government proposes to set up Biodiversity Parks;
- (b) whether the Central Government is aware that the Department conducted a survey to set up Biodiversity Park in Naro hills in Satna District and whether the Government of Madhya Pradesh has also sent a proposal in this regard;
- (c) if so, the status of the said proposal; and
- (d) the number of biodiversity parks set up in the country so far and the details of the source from which financial assistance is provided to them?

(a) to (d) Biological Parks are established and developed by the concerned States and Union Territories for protection and conservation of biodiversity. As per the information received from the States and UTs, the details of Biodiversity Parks established in the country are at Annexure-I.

A proposal for Rs. 1.45 crore under CAMPA funds was submitted by the Government of Madhya Pradesh to the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change for conservation of natural resources in the forest area of Naro Hills, Satna District, Madhya Pradesh, which has been duly approved.
